


# ANNUAL MINNOWBROOK WEEKEND

August 4-6, 2017

***Join Artist Warren Kimble '57  
and the Central New York Alumni Club  
for an entertaining weekend in the beautiful  
Adirondack Mountains***



As "America's Best Known Living Folk Artist," Warren Kimble has enjoyed a more than 50-year career as a fine artist, educator, and antique collector to create a casual but sophisticated style of American Folk Art. His art features the animals, rural landscapes and buildings of Vermont. As Warren himself says, his style is "reminiscent of something that surrounds a person every day. It is simplistic, yet abstract." Kimble will share his perspectives on a wide range of topics including

- \* *His art and career*
- \* *The value of art to society and community*
- \* *Public art, art education and the importance of funding the arts*
- \* *The re-invigoration of the town of Brandon, VT supported by the Brandon Artists Guild, of which Kimble is a leading member*

As a special treat, you'll be able to make your own "Warren Kimble Project!" Warren will direct us in painting leaves we collect and then "printing" them onto a bowl/box (TBD). Only \$25 per project covers all the supplies you'll need (optional).

This amazing weekend includes 2 nights lodging at Minnowbrook (an Adirondack Great Camp), 6 delicious meals prepared by Minnowbrook's gourmet chef, and 2 receptions. Refreshments are always available. We'll gather on Friday afternoon before dinner and our weekend ends after lunch on Sunday. The cost is \$510/person for a single room and \$455/person in a double room.



Warren and Lorraine, his wife and business partner live and work in the Vermont town of Brandon, where they have been deeply involved in civic life and philanthropy for over forty years. Warren graduated with a B.F.A. from SU in 1957. While at Syracuse, Warren was a member of many organizations, including the SU Cheer Squad. During his long career he has been in advertising, taught in public schools and also at Castleton State College in Vermont. He received SU's George Arents Pioneer Medal in 2002, and an honorary Doctor of Fine Arts degree from Green Mountain College, Poultney, VT. Minnowbrook is a unique 28-acre mountain retreat owned and operated by Syracuse University. It was designed in the lavish, grand-lodge Adirondack Great Camp style of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Minnowbrook is only 3 hours from Syracuse and 2 hours from Albany! You will have time to explore area destinations such as the [Adirondack Museum](#) or the [Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts](#) located nearby in the village of Blue Mountain Lake, or the [Natural History Museum of the Adirondacks](#), located approximately 30 miles away in Tupper Lake.


