- How science has been distorted by all sides of environmental issues and how storytelling should be used to communicate effectively to counter distortion
- Truth and fakery in Reality TV
- Is today's manufactured pop music "real" music or not

Siegel earned degrees in geology from the University of Rhode Island (BS) and Penn State (MS), and his doctorate in Hydrogeology from the University of Minnesota. Since retiring in 2017, Don's "day job" consists of environmental consulting, mentoring high school students in SU's Project Advance program, and serving as the current President of the Geological Society of America. Don plays jazz guitar at wineries, coffeehouses, and receptions in Syracuse. He and his wife, Bette, love visiting their grandkids and kids.
